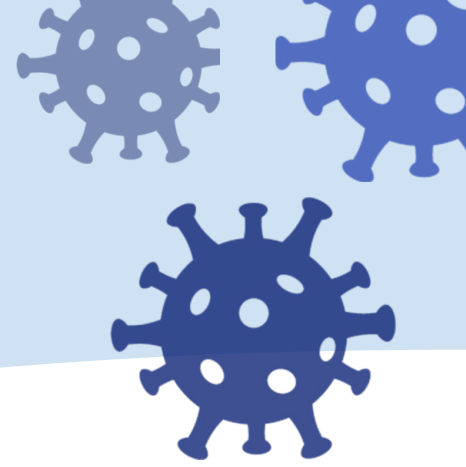


# At-Home COVID-19 Testing



Getting tested for COVID-19 is important if you've been in close contact with someone who has COVID-19 or if you have symptoms. This holiday season, we want to make it as easy as possible to get a test. If you cannot go to a drive up or walk-up testing site, **you can get a free COVID-19 test mailed to your home.**

From now until March 14th, 2021, certain LA County residents will be able to complete free testing in the comfort of their homes – **regardless of immigration, employment or insurance status.** You can get a free test kit mailed to your home if you:

1. Have symptoms of COVID-19
2. Were in close contact with someone who has or thinks they have COVID-19 in the past 2 weeks
3. Are a senior or person with a disability who feels they were exposed to COVID-19 and are unable to go to a testing site.

These free at-home testing kits are **easy and safe to use!** Remember, as you wait to get any COVID-19 test, it's important you stay home and avoid contact with others, even in your household. Be sure to wear a mask and wash your hands often.

At-Home COVID-19 tests are easy to complete from the comfort of your home, just follow the instructions included in the test kit. Once you receive the test kit, **take the test as soon as it arrives.**

**Sign-up** for the at-home test online

**Collect** the sample by using the instructions

**Ship** the at-home test via FedEx

**Isolate** and stay away from others, even in your home, as you await results

All of the steps above must be done **ON THE SAME DAY.**
