New COVID-19 hotspots

LA COUNTY IS EXPERIENCING AN INCREASE IN COVID-19 INFECTIONS IN VARIOUS COMMUNITIES. PLEASE HELP US STOP THE SPREAD BY URGING COMMUNITY MEMBERS TO GET TESTED.

As vaccines roll out, testing is key to avoiding new COVID-19 surges, and to prevent more members of our communities from getting sick. It is critical that community members know: If they are not fully vaccinated, it's important to get tested if they've been exposed to COVID-19 or feel sick.

The LA County Department of Health Services is seeing **increases in infections in Antelope Valley - Lancaster/Palmdale, Pacoima/Arleta, Acton and South LA**. Please help raise awareness about the importance of testing and where to get tested:
